

MEETING MINUTES COASTAL BEND COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS December 8, 2023-2:00 PM

The meeting of the Board of Directors of the Coastal Bend Council of Governments was held at 2:00 pm on Friday, December 8, 2023. 1. CALL TO ORDER
